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Learning Outcomes

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Sunny Boy Jim Jack Jones Sings Songs of Learning and Love is a wonderful and creative music based program, through which to teach and reinforce lessons and concepts of unity, kindness, empathy, diversity, inclusion, and membership. The music and program are primarily designed for K-5 but, the lessons and takeaways are great for everyone. And, no matter what the child's age, all lessons and learning outcomes, language, and activities are designed to be age appropriate no matter what the demographic.

While maintaining respect for the content and dynamics of diversity, inclusion, empathy, equity, belonging, and membership, this music based program includes varied and effective elements of fun and interaction. The music is all super child friendly – with positive personal and social values and morals – created from a true perspective of kindness, inclusiveness and difference. It is an acoustic music based program featuring, singalongs, percussion jams, and lots of positive interactivity and fun built into each song.

Workshops are designed to address multiple learning styles including: Aural (auditory-musical); Verbal (linguistic); Physical (kinesthetic); Logical (mathematical); Social (interpersonal); Solitary (intra-personal)

With Sunny Boy, students are getting a great diversity & inclusion, team work, empathy, empowerment, self-value, and leadership based education. The skills acquired are not only effective in school or class, but throughout life.

We also bring all supplies and hand percussion instruments for the participants to use throughout their Sunny Boy session(s). A Song/Activities book is also given to each participant as a free takeaway.
